## For deferred graduation students

- 1. Calculation method for deferred graduation students of the university: In principle, fees and charges follow the standards set by the classes offered by the year level.
- 2. Deferred graduation students of the undergraduate program: Those who are making up credits below nine credits should pay the per credit fee; those taking more than nine credits should pay the entire amount of the tuition and miscellaneous fees. Non-credit subjects like military training and P.E. are not included in the calculations of "total credits," but for these students should pay by the number of hours attended.
- 3. From the second semester of Academic Year 2013, deferred graduation students of undergraduate programs should pay their miscellaneous fees in accordance with the table below, with the cumulative number of credits used to calculate the necessary amount of miscellaneous fees. When the cumulative number of credits is not equal to the cumulative hours, the latter shall be used to calculate the amount of miscellaneous fees.

N.B. The miscellaneous fee standards are in accordance with those of the College of Humanities and Social Science, and are based on the miscellaneous fees vis-a-vis number of credits. Calculation formula is [(per credit charge of each college x number of credits) + (NT\$7,469 x number of credits/9)]. The miscellaneous fee standards for deferred graduation students are shown in the above table

- 4. For students in the master's degree program and those in the in-service master program, who have completed four semesters, on the 5th semester, those who are only taking the non-credit "Thesis Advisement" should still pay the base rate of the tuition and miscellaneous fees. This also applies to students in the PhD program who have completed six semester; they have to follow the abovementioned rule on their 7th semester. Those taking less than 9 credits have to pay the per credit charge and the base rate of the tuition and miscellaneous fees while those taking 10 or more credits will have to pay the full rate of the tuition and miscellaneous fees.
- 5. If taking cross-departmental courses entail other charges, fee standards will be based on the year level offering the course.
- 6. Two-year in-service education program: Per credit charge is calculated. When the cumulative number of credits is not equal to the cumulative hours, the latter shall be used to calculate the amount of fees.
- 7. For non-credit courses like military training and P.E.: Credit charges paid according to number of class hours (undergraduate students: NT\$1,292/hr.; students of the bachelor program of extension education: calculated according to the per credit charge of the department offering the class)
- 8. General education courses: NT\$1,292 per credit.

The fee standards of each academic system of the university (including those for deferred graduation students) are in accordance with the credit charge calculation method. When the cumulative number of credits is not equal to the cumulative hours, the latter shall be used to calculate the amount of miscellaneous fees.
